High Hazard Fireworks Display Permit Requirements

A High Hazard Display Fireworks Permit Application requires; and **NO PERMIT** may be issued without the following items:

- 1) Proof of possession of a Natural Resources Canada Fireworks Supervisor Level 1 or Level 2 Card appropriate for the fireworks to be used in the display, for each individual who will purchase, handle, discharge, fire or set off any fireworks material and or devices. **(Photocopy of license with picture ID is acceptable)**
- 2) A **Certificate of Liability Insurance** document for the High Hazard Display in the amount of \$5,000,000.00 that includes naming Brandon Fire & Emergency Services, the City of Brandon as additional insured. **(Photocopy of Certificate is acceptable)**
- 3) Written permission to conduct a fireworks display from the property owner or agent of the land **and** the owner or agent of neighboring land on which fireworks debris might reasonably be expected to fall.
- 4) A site plan that includes separation distances to the public, location of ramps and mortars, fallout zone, direction of firing and significant ground features, (ie. Roadways, buildings or other structures, overhead obstructions, parking areas, spectator viewing areas) and location of security personnel and public restraints.
- 5) An event description that includes the time that the fireworks will be on site, time of site lock down, time of set-up completion, a list of devices and effects to be used, firing procedures, description of site security and site cleanup.

Note: An inspection of the proposed site will be required prior to issuing the permit. A demonstration of the display fireworks may be required prior to issuing the permit. The demonstration for inspection purposes shall be scheduled with sufficient time allowed for resetting or reloading the high hazard display fireworks before the arrival of the spectators. Additional precautions may be required after an assessment by Brandon Fire & Emergency Services prior to issuing the High Hazard Display Fireworks Permit.

This permit application is to be submitted to Brandon Fire & Emergency Services one (1) week prior to date of the Fireworks Display. (No late applications will be considered).

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Note:

1. Applicant must be the person supervising the High Hazard Fireworks Display.
2. Application approval is subject to the conditions listed on the accompanying page.
